## NOTES

- General English, Intensive English, Combination and Private tuition start any Monday, or where necessary due to public holidays, Tuesday.
  - Examination dates are scheduled and set by University of Cambridge ESOL Examinations and are outside of the control of Atlantic Language Galway. Dates shown are for written papers only.
  - Cambridge Examination Preparation (CEPxxx) courses require a minimum entry level of English (this may be confirmed by a pre-test from Atlantic Language Galway):
    - Standard Courses (i.e. courses longer than 8 weeks' duration)
    - Intermediate level required for FCE and Upper Intermediate for CAE.
    - Intensive courses (i.e. courses shorter than 8 weeks' duration)
    - Upper Intermediate level required for FCE and Advanced for CAE.
  - General English with Business (GE1B) course requires a minimum entry level of English of Intermediate.
  - A textbook (BOOK) is required for all GE1x and GE2 courses. A set of two textbooks (CEPTB) is required for all Cambridge (CEPxxx) courses.
  - Private tuition, focusing on General English topics, takes place in afternoon classes only and may be scheduled between 1330 and 1730, Monday to Friday.
  - Accommodation fees are non-refundable.
- The school is open every Monday to Friday from 4 January to 17 December 2010 with the exception of the following public and school holidays:
    - 17 March; 2 April; 5 April; 3 May; 7 June; 2 August; and 25 October. Christmas holidays are taken from 20 December 2010 to 2 January 2011, inclusive.
  - Students will not be refunded for tuition missed due to Public Holidays.
  - Special Courses, including Cambridge Examination Preparation (CEPxxx), Discovery (Dxx) and Teacher Training (TRC) courses are offered on defined dates
  - General Business with English (GE1B), Standard General English Afternoons (GE1A), Discover Ireland West for the Over 50s (D50), Teacher Training (TRC) and Cambridge Examination Preparation (CEPxx) courses all require a minimum of 8 people to run. If this is not reached Agents will be informed at least 3 weeks in advance of course commencement and an alternative will be arranged.
  - In high season students who arrive mid-week to do their placement test may have to wait until the following Monday before being placed in class.
