



ENGLISH LANGUAGE COURSES 2010

The Language Centre of Ireland is open from 11 January-17 December 2010

National Holidays : 1 & 4 January, 17 March, 2 & 5 April, 3 May, 7 June, 2 August and 25 October, 25-28 December 2010.

Standard and Intensive courses are available throughout the year at all levels from Beginner to Advanced.

You may start a course on any Monday. Minimum course duration is one week. Minimum age 18 years.

Each lesson is of 55 minutes duration.

STANDARD COURSE (20 lessons per week)

The aim of this course is to help you communicate in spoken and written English. The course covers listening, speaking, reading and writing. The structure of the language is taught within a conversational framework. Course materials and methods are modern, progressive and appropriate to your needs.

Course Hours: Monday-Friday 09.00-13.00

Course Fees: Euro 210 per week

INTENSIVE COURSE (26 lessons per week)

This course is intended for those who wish to make rapid progress in English. Four 55-minute lessons each morning provide systematic practice in essential language skills, while in the afternoon emphasis is placed on helping you to communicate more fluently and clearly in English.

Course Hours: Monday-Friday 09.00-13.00

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday 14.30-16.30

Course Fees: Euro 255 per week

BUSINESS ENGLISH (20 lessons per week)

This course enables participants to understand and practice the fundamentals of effective business communication through English. The course is designed in a practical way to cover the English needed in everyday business situations, including sales talk, marketing, presentations, analysing business figures and telephone English. Business English is available throughout the year from Intermediate level +.

Ideal for students already working or training in the areas of General Management, Administration, Marketing, Sales and Customer Relations who wish to further their skills.

Students of Finance and Banking may also benefit from this course. However it is not intended as a specialist course covering one area in great depth.

Cambridge Examination Preparation Courses

The University of Cambridge examinations are internationally recognised as evidence of a high standard of spoken and written English. Our courses are designed to give you the thorough preparation required for these examinations.

There are three levels, Cambridge First Certificate (FCE), Cambridge Advanced English (CAE) and Cambridge Proficiency in English (CPE). Each level consists of five separate examination papers covering reading, writing and grammar, listening and speaking.

**Please note that the oral examinations may be held up to and including Saturday 13 March, Saturday 19 June and Saturday 11 December 2010. Students taking these examinations are strongly advised not to confirm return tickets until they have received their examination timetable.*

Students may not enter a Cambridge course until they have taken a special pre-test. This test is to discover which Cambridge examination a student should register for. Students will also receive individualised advice concerning which areas of their English they need to concentrate on to be successful in the examination.

It is important that students join the course at the beginning in order to allow time for assessment before the closing date for registration for the examination. The Language Centre of Ireland is unable to accept examination registrations made in advance of the student's arrival at the school. Please note that students must register in person for the examination in the LCI office.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation can be arranged, on request, for students studying full time courses at LCI. Accommodation is with a host family; part-board (bed, breakfast and evening meal) Monday to Friday and full board (all meals) Saturday & Sunday.

Accommodation Rate: Euro170 per week. Each extra night Euro 28.

There is an administration fee of Euro 65 for arranging accommodation, exclusive of accommodation fee and non-refundable.

During the academic year (October-June) students will normally have a single room. However, a request for a single room during the busy summer months (July to September) will be subject to a supplement of **Euro 36** per week. Students of over 30 years and upwards should request a single room unless they are travelling with a friend with whom they share.

TERMS

The minimum period of family accommodation is one week. No refund will be made to a student who makes alternative arrangements during this time. Students wishing to stay longer than the period booked must notify the office. No allowance will be made for absence from the family for occasional days. Students who wish to vacate their rooms for five days or longer will be charged a retainer fee of Euro 25 per week. Special requests should be directed to our Accommodation Office. Surcharges may apply in some cases.

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
