Info about the school

Worldwide School is located in mid Auckland city (since 2008). The school is inside The Strand Building 233 Queen St, a four storey classic Victorian 1900's building. They are on level 3 and 4. On the third floor there are 14 classrooms, a recreation area, prayer room, a kitchen and bathrooms. On the fourth floor is our administration area, teacher's room and library/self study area, internet computer room, the movie theatre, recreational outdoor deck area, student lounge with kitchen, bathrooms and 7 classrooms.

Visa-regulations for EU-citizens:

A number of countries have a **Working Holiday Visa** agreement with NZ (and more are added each year). In 2006 these countries were:

Argentina, Belgium, Chile, Czech Republic, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Italy, Japan, Korea , Malaysia, Netherlands, Sweden, Taiwan, Thailand and Uruguay.

Most EU citizens with working holiday visa rights can apply on line for this visa either in Europe or in New Zealand.

Visa-regulations for Non-EU-citizens:

Students from countries who are not visa free need to apply for a visa from their country.
