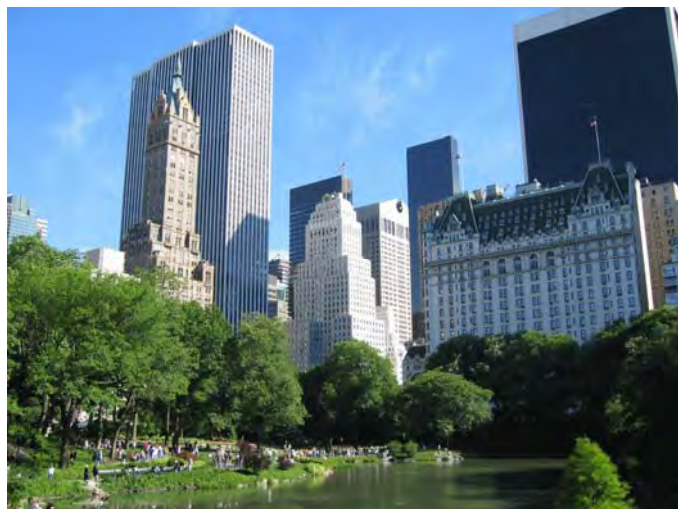

Die Stadt:



Die Millionenstadt New York hat seinen Besuchern viel zu bieten. Wer kulturell interessiert ist, findet hier eine Vielzahl von Museen, Theatern, Kinos und andere interessante Veranstaltungen, wie z.B. den Off-Broadway.

New York selbst hat ca. 8 Millionen Einwohner, wobei 1,5 Millionen dem County Manhattan zugeordnet werden. An der Ostküste der USA gelegen, wurde die Stadt 1613 gegründet und zunächst von Niederländern besiedelt.

Sehenswürdigkeiten, die einen Besuch New Yorks lohnenswert machen, sind unter anderem das berühmte Chinatown, der Central Park, das American Museum of Natural History oder die Wall Street. Der gut ausgebaute ÖPNV ermöglicht es, überall schnell und günstig hin zu gelangen.

Die Schule:

Rennert Bilingual hat zwei Standorte in den USA – Miami und New York. Gegründet wurde die Schule 1973. Mitten in Manhattan gelegen, ist sie leicht mit dem ÖPNV zu erreichen. Im Gegensatz zu anderen Schulen in den USA, wird die Schülerzahl mit maximal 10 Teilnehmern pro Kurs klein gehalten.

Rennert hat für alle Sprachlevel einen Kurs anzubieten – vom Anfänger bis zum Fortgeschrittenen. Für New York ist die Schule mit einer Maximalkapazität von 350 Schülern jedoch vergleichbar klein. Somit wird ein angenehmes, familiäres Klima geschaffen, das den Lernprozess fördert.

Es gibt ein breites Angebot von Spezialkursen wie Wirtschaftsentenglisch oder Executive Kurse. Aber auch Profikurse zusammen mit einer Filmakademie und Schauspielschule sind verfügbar.

Terms and Conditions - Studies and Tuition

- All students must have paid for their program IN FULL by the FIRST day of classes or they will not be permitted to attend classes.
- No tuition refunds will be made after classes begin regardless of reason for departure. Cancellations must be submitted in writing.
- The \$145 Registration Fee is not refundable but may be applied toward future registrations in the same calendar year.
- Tuition and Study Materials Fees are refundable for those who cancel two weeks or more before their intended start date. Rennert will make all refunds within 30 days only to the person or agency that paid the school. Students who have paid their tuition through agents must apply to that agency for a refund.
- Program changes post arrival require four weeks notice and are subject to a \$60 program change fee. There are no changes on programs of four weeks or less.
- Students participating in English programs at Rennert must be at least 17 years of age and non-native speakers of English.
- Students will be assigned to afternoon or morning schedules based on level and space availability. There are no guaranteed morning classes.
- Prices and policies are subject to change with approval of the New York State Education Department.
- This school is authorized under Federal law to enroll non-immigrant alien students. César Rennert is a certified sales agent for Rennert. He is registered with the NY State Education Department Bureau of Proprietary School Supervision and his sales license number is #11552508.

Terms and Conditions - Accommodations

- Requests for living accommodations must be received at least four weeks prior to the start date.
- Students must arrive the Sunday before classes begin and depart the Saturday following the last day of classes.
- Accommodations are only available to Rennert students during their study period. Overnight guests are not permitted.
- We cannot guarantee space in the first choice of accommodations.
- Prices are subject to change due to availability.
- Accommodations cannot be confirmed until a rule acknowledgement form is signed and a housing deposit equivalent to two weeks is paid. The housing deposit must be paid at least two weeks prior to arrival or accommodation reservations will be released.
- We require four weeks notice to change or cancel accommodations post arrival.
- There are no refunds or changes on reservations of four weeks or less.
- Housing deposit is refundable if cancelled two weeks or more prior to arrival date.
- A fee of \$80 will be charged for all accommodation cancellations or changes made after arrival date at Rennert New York.
- A fee of \$150 will be charged for all accommodation cancellations or changes made after arrival date at Rennert Miami.
