Dublin Airport Individual Transfer Service "A": Individuals arriving and departing at certain times can avail of this service. Students will be met at the airport by a company representative. Students will then travel to Galway via coach with our transfer partner: On arrival in Galway students will be met by host families and / or an Atlantic Language Galway representative. This is an unaccompanied coach transfer with our transfer partner: Flight Arrival Times: Saturday OR Sunday from 09.00 to 17.00*subject to changes in scheduled flights Flight Departure Times: Saturday OR Sunday from 11.00 to 20.00*subject to changes in scheduled flights	€150 return
Dublin Airport Individual Transfer Service "B": This is to suit individuals travelling outside of the above mentioned flight arrival / departure times. Students will be met at the airport by a company representative. Students will then travel to Galway via coach with our transfer partner: On arrival in Galway students will be met by host families and / or an Atlantic Language Galway representative. Last available coach departure from Dublin Airport - Galway is 21.15. This is an unaccompanied coach transfer with our transfer partner.	€150 single

TUITION

- › 28 lessons (21 hours) of group English language tuition per week in 5 morning lessons: Monday to Friday 09.30-13.00, and
 - › 4 afternoon lessons: Monday - Thursday afternoon 14.15 - 15.45*
 - › Class size - maximum 15 students per class. 5 Levels - Elementary to Advanced
- * Excluding week one where orientation of Galway City may take place on first afternoon

Discussion and feedback from students, teachers, and group leaders has led to the development of a programme at Atlantic Language Galway which places an increased focus and emphasis on the academic elements of our junior school syllabus. Students, teachers, and parents alike have all commented that they desire a course where students have the possibility to learn and practise as much English as possible during their time in their adopted country. In the past, it has been felt that certain courses contained a lot of activities which were not necessarily connected strongly enough to tangible English language learning. These activities were often viewed as "time-fillers" that took up time which could be spent on more practical and useful English language learning endeavours.

Atlantic Language aims to distinguish itself from other programmes and schools through the development of a unique summer school timetable which maximises the amount of in-class and teacher contact time where students are actually learning and practising their newly acquired language skills. By doing so, it is hoped that our school can establish itself as a premier academic junior international summer school, which places English language instruction as the most important cornerstone of our school's ethos.

TOURS

Our students travel on 1 Full-day Tour each Weekend. This weekly tour is included in the programme.

- › Full day tour to Dublin
- › Cliffs of Moher and the Burren
- › Aran Islands
- › Tour of Connemara
- › Bunratty Castle and Folk Park

SOCIAL, CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY PROGRAMME

- › English Language Project Work – complete a group project on a topic of Irish culture
- › Irish Music and Dance – have fun while learning the traditional steps of Irish dance
- › Bowling – enjoy an evening out bowling with your friends and classmates
- › English Language Quiz – in teams students test their general knowledge through English
- › Disco – fancy dress disco with prizes for the most inventive costume!!
- › Movie Night – time to relax and watch your favourite movies
- › Talent Show – students sing, dance, act, and entertain their friends and other groups. Prizes for the best entries!!
- › Greyhound Racing – enjoy a traditional Irish night at the races!!
