# Ramsgate Excursion Information 2010

## Canterbury

Canterbury and the surrounding area has a whole host of history and heritage for you to come and discover. Canterbury is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and two castles, six museums and an attraction that lets you step back in time to the Middle Ages are some of what is on offer here in historic Canterbury.



## Windsor & Eton

Students will take a short journey to Windsor where they will have a tour around the picturesque city. The tour will then take them to Eton, the school to most of the Royal Family. Students will then have free time to explore the castle (at an extra cost) or time for shopping.



## Brighton

Brighton is a rich mix of Regency heritage, boutique shopping, arts, beachfront cool & year round events. Students will have a chance to visit the famous pier and shop in "the Lanes" before an opportunity to visit the beautiful Royal Pavilion\*



## London

After taking a scenic boat ride along the Thames river from Greenwich, taking in just a few of the many famous sights that the capital has to offer along the way, students arrive at the Embankment and are immediately thrown into the unmistakable hustle and bustle of London. They will then be taken on a tour of Central London's main features, including Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Horse Guard Parade, St. James Palace, St. James Park, Buckingham Palace and Trafalgar Square, learning a little bit about the history of each attraction as they see them. The students will then be given free time to check out the ever lively shopping area of Covent Garden, which is full of street performers, places to eat and big name shops, before being taken back to the Embankment for one last look at the Thames before catching the coach home. Some students may want to add to their London experience by visiting the impressive Tower of London, which houses the Queen's Crown Jewels or by rubbing shoulders with some of their favourite celebrities at the world famous Madame Tussauds Waxwork Museum – and if so, Churchill House members of staff will be on hand to accompany them to these additional destinations.



## Bath And Stonehenge

Students will first visit Stonehenge, a ring of stones that remain one of England's greatest mysterious icons. Then they will make the short journey to Bath where they will take a tour of the city and a visit the Roman baths from which the city gets its name. There will then be free time to go shopping and explore the city and all its wonders.



## Oxford

After arriving at Oxford, Students will be taken on a history-packed tour. Students will then pass by and learn more about all of Oxford's main attractions, including the Ashmolean Museum (the world's oldest public museum!), Blackwells Bookshop, the Sheldonian Theatre, the Bodleian Library and the Radcliffe Camera, not too mention passing numerous colleges of the University of Oxford along the way. The tour finishing the highly prestigious and famous Christ Church college. Students will then have free time to eat their lunch by the scenic backdrop of the college and then wander off to explore Oxford for themselves – either shopping in the city's more modern areas or further discovering the rich history of a city that houses one of the finest academic centres of learning in the world.



## Cambridge

Students will arrive next to Queens College – one of the University of Cambridge's 34 colleges – and will then make their way towards the town, passing the river Cam and the many punters on the river as they walk. After a short visit around Pembroke College, to get an idea of just what a Cambridge College looks like, the students will enter the town centre and begin a short tour of the city's most significant colleges, starting at the majestic Kings College and then passing Senate House, Trinity College, St. Johns College, the town's famous Round Church and Emmanuel College, as well as other colleges that can be seen along the trail. Once the tour ends, students will have free time to explore this traditional university town and its prestigious colleges
