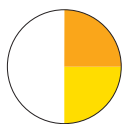

## location

Granada is a picturesque city ideally set at the foothills of the Sierra Nevada and just 45 minutes from the famous beaches of the “Costa Tropical.” It’s a great place for youngsters to discover many of the highlights of Spanish culture, from incredible relics of the past like the Royal Chapel and stunning Alhambra to signature traditions like flamenco and tapas.

Classes are held in a school near the residence hall, and both are conveniently located in the center of Granada.

### ACCOMMODATIONS

Accommodations are in an EnfoCamp residence or with a host family, located at a maximum of 20 minutes from the school. Both are supervised by our counselors. Our residence in Granada consists of double or triple rooms, many with their own private bathroom. Additionally, facilities include: shared bathrooms, common rooms with TV, air conditioning and a fully equipped kitchen run by the residence staff.
