The camp consists of 2 main sections: a residence where the students stay plus another section of school where classes are held. Within the residence, facilities include: nicely sized bedrooms with windows facing gardens, a common room with TV, a games room and a cafeteria. The shared bathrooms are very large with separate stalls for sinks, toilets and showers. The camp has its own kitchen with 2 large dining halls, as well as sporting facilities. There is an off-site public pool available for student use.

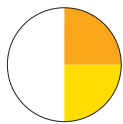
