



## OISE Oxford Advanced Learners Programme 2012 Factsheet: Jesus College

OISE Oxford is proud to announce that this summer our Advanced Learners Programme for ambitious, young individuals is returning following the great success in 2011. The programme will take place at Oxford University's Jesus College. Students will sleep, dine and study within the historic walls of Jesus College.

Jesus College was founded in 1571 by Queen Elizabeth I and it is the only Oxford College to date from Elizabeth's reign. The compact central College site has beautiful quadrangles tucked away off Turl Street, right in the heart of Oxford. Former students include Harold Wilson (who was twice British Prime Minister) and T. E. Lawrence ("Lawrence of Arabia").



The programme is fully residential. Students will eat breakfast, lunch and an evening meal within the historic wood paneled dining hall. All bedrooms are single and well equipped including a desk and a chair and some have a shared lounge. There will be a maximum of 4 students per shower room. Wash basins are in every bedroom.
