Programme

22.5 hours per week, maximum class size of 8 students

During the morning students develop their accuracy in speaking, listening, reading and writing. Afternoon oral and communications skills workshops through games and activities are designed to encourage fluency and build confidence in speaking the language. The late afternoon programme gives the students the opportunity to participate in cultural and leisure activities which further enhance their learning experience.

Dating back to the Saxon age, Taunton is situated between the Quantock and Blackdown hills in the heart of the south west of England, with the beautiful River Tone running through it. The town itself is situated 50km from Exeter, 80km from Bristol and 230km west of London.

King's Hall School is ideal for the younger student with a safe and friendly atmosphere. As all staff live on campus there is 24 hour supervision and gives the centre a real family feel which encourages our youngest learners to flourish in their linguistic abilities.

OISE Taunton has a wide range of facilities including a sports hall, tennis courts, heated outdoor swimming pool and a woodland assault course.



Accommodation

- Accommodation is in dormitories which sleep 6 to 8 in a room. Special care is taken to put students of a similar age and ability in the same rooms. Furthermore, all bedrooms are well-furnished and comfortable.
- Meals are provided in the school dining hall. Special dietary requirements can be considered and a vegetarian option is always available.

A typical day at Taunton

Morning

- 09.00 Assembly
- 09.30 Lessons: reading and writing
- 11.00 Break
- 11.30 Lessons: listening and understanding
- 13.00 Lunch

Afternoon

- 14.00 Workshops to encourage fluency and use of the language., through games and activities
- 15.15 Break
- 15.45 Afternoon activities include sports, swimming, computer room, art room, birds of prey, theatre workshop, circus skills, bowling, dance, talent show and a shopping trip.

Evening

- 18.00 Dinner
- 18.30 Supervised homework
- 19.30 Evening leisure programme. Typical activities include film night, disco, barbecue, card games, sports, team/music games, art, treasure hunt, games room, tennis and games on the field.
- 21.00 Hot drink and bedtime

The school day is for illustrative purposes and may be subject to change.



Excursions

Every Saturday, there is a full day excursion either to Crealy Adventure Theme Park or Wookey Hole and Clarks Shopping Village.

Sunday is filled with activities such as sports, music workshops, swimming, bouncy castle, wacky races, art challenge and music games.
