The School

Tennis, football, basketball, arts & crafts, drama, treasure hunt, swimming, baseball, volleyball, team games, trampolining.

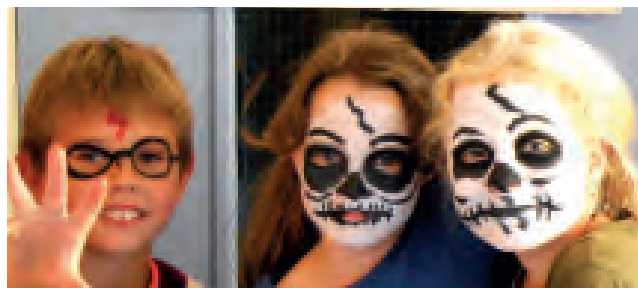
Evening Activities

Laundry
