The School

The University of Kent, Canterbury campus is situated within 300 acres of tranquil parkland, overlooking the historic city of Canterbury. The campus offers a mixture of gardens, ponds, woodland and modern facilities including shops, sports equipment and a theatre.

Location

The campus is just 20 minutes from the beach, 90 kilometres from London and within walking distance of Canterbury with its internationally renowned Cathedral.

All meals are included. Students choose from a self-service buffet, a selection of hot and cold meals are available. Vegetarian and special diets are catered for.

Trips & visits

- You leave Canterbury at 09.00 on Saturday morning and return at 18.30 on Sunday evening.
- You will stay in a twin room at London Bank side (part of the London School of Economics).
- The residence is situated on the south bank of the River Thames. From here it is just a short journey into the centre of London with its shops, theatres, museums and amusements.
- You will have plenty of time to explore London with your friends. All at no additional cost for the weekend experience
- Through student opinion additional activities are organised for example football matches, cinema etc



Laundry

A laundry service is provided for students once a week. Although bed linen is provided in the student residence, students are asked to bring their own towels.

Clothes/Sports equipment

Students are recommended to prepare for good and bad weather and bring enough warm clothes. Students should bring suitable sportswear, white-soled footwear for sports halls, swimwear, towel and a sports bag.

Airport transfers

We meet you on arrival day and escort you on departure day. This service is included in the course price for arrivals 09.00–17.00 and departures 09.00–15.00.

Arrivals

Upon arrival at the school the Course Director collects passports, airline tickets and pocket money from each student for safe-keeping. Students can withdraw money from the school bank whenever necessary.
