Visa-regulations for EU-citizens:

If you want to do an internship as a student or work after completing your apprenticeship, you will need a “Young Workers Exchange Program” visa.

However, you will not be able to change your employer under this visa.

If you want to do Work & Travel, you have to apply for the Working Holiday Visas (Germans, French, Dutch, Swedes and Danes are eligible to get these visas at our Canadian Embassies, all other nationalities must get a Student Visa plus a Coop Work Permit).

Under the Working Holiday Visa you can work for various employers and stay in the country after completion of your internship. Please note that the number of WH-visas is highly restricted and it is hard to get one.
