<b>Sunday</b>	Arrival at Edinburgh Airport and transfer to accommodation (not included)
<b>Monday</b>	4 group lessons at inlingua Edinburgh in the morning. Afternoon tour to the Botanic Gardens of Dawyck set in the rolling hills of the Borders (Some tours will visit Traquair House instead).
<b>Tuesday</b>	4 group lessons at inlingua Edinburgh in the morning. Afternoon excursion to Newhailes, one of Edinburgh's best-kept secrets. A fine Georgian house that has been preserved by the National Trust. Step back in time before heading for Shepherd House, a privately-owned house with delightful gardens.
<b>Wednesday</b>	4 group lessons at inlingua Edinburgh in the morning. Afternoon visit to Arniston House, south of Edinburgh. This fine Palladian style mansion house has been in the Dundas family for more than 400 years!
<b>Thursday</b>	Full day tour via Stirling to Drummond Castle Gardens, one of Europe's finest formal gardens in glorious settings. Wander around the French gardens before continuing to Scone Palace, home to the Earl of Mansfield and the historic Stone of Destiny, Scotland's oldest throne. We return via the Forth Road bridge with an amazing view of the iconic Forth Rail Bridge.
<b>Friday</b>	4 group lessons at inlingua Edinburgh in the morning. Afternoon visit to Little Sparta, the private gardens of the Scottish artist and poet Ian Hamilton Finlay who set more than 200 of his art objects in beautiful surroundings (some tours will visit a different garden instead).
<b>Sunday</b>	Return transfer to Edinburgh Airport (not included) or continuation of stay.
