**2017** saw some significant **innovations** to our programme which, at the time of writing, appear to have been quite successful. The most important of these has been the additions to the Young Adult programme and I am including details of these below as a reminder for 2018.

Very little more is actually new. The course prices remain **UNCHANGED**, there are some price increases on accommodation and meal plans.

We continue the substantial improvement in our meal service by allowing the students with meal tickets to choose freely from the breakfast buffet. This largely explains the price rise in meal plans.

The most substantial difference you will see on the School Campus if you visit in 2018 will be that practically all the bedrooms of the Club Hispanico have now been renovated to a high standard. The latest are 8 more standard single rooms – still small but now with “wow” factor, and the refurbished triple rooms with new flooring, 3 single beds and a new design. **All reasons why this is Spain's most popular language school residence!**

## Reminders .....Up-dates .....Reminders.....

Some important reminders from the last years and up-dates on recurring themes:

- **Erasmus+:** most of our courses of 1-4 weeks' duration can be included in an Erasmus+ application for teachers and school staff: Teachers of Spanish can take Spanish and methodology programmes, other teachers and admin staff can take general Spanish or courses such as Spanish + Cookery, Spanish + Dance, Business Spanish etc, according to their needs and objectives. - All but 10 of the en-suite bedrooms in our **Club Hispanico** are now renovated to a very high standard – this is the most popular on-site language school residence in Spain.
- **Free WiFi** in all types of accommodation: Club Hispanico, Host families, Student Apartments.
- University programmes: Pathways and others:
  - **University Semester:** a Gap-Year programme including the “experience” of a term studying beside Spanish University students
  - **PCE/Selectividad:** Once again Spain has changed the name of the Undergraduate Degree entry exam. There are also some minor changes in content. This is not totally clear at the time of writing but information will be provided on request. We will ensure that the students receive a valid preparation programme.
  - **Masters' Pathway:** linguistic preparation and counselling to help students enter Official Masters programmes at Spanish Universities.
- Renovation of Salon Andalucia: a more modern but still cosy feel with vastly improved facilities for our **Spanish & Cookery** programme.
- Renovation of the **Bar and Restaurant** area: a complete transformation to create a more fresh and modern environment – it gained many compliments from agents, students and school owners when they saw it for the first time at Malaca Instituto's 45<sup>th</sup> Anniversary party in January.
- Cookery & Spanish for **VET groups:** ask for details of tailor-made programmes of Cookery plus Spanish for groups of students from Vocational Training schools (VET) which could be covered by Erasmus+ funding.
- **“Enhanced” Airport Transfer** for younger students: for under 16s this is obligatory and other under 18s its an option. The transfer driver on the return transfer ensures that the student is placed in the correct check-in queue.
- **Breakage deposits:** After the successful introduction of the €100 deposit for the Type A apartments, we have now decided to introduce this for Type B as well from 2018. This should be paid in cash on arrival and we would be grateful if you could ensure that your students are aware of this.

### Renovation of the Club:

- Floor 5 of the Club Hispánico now has an impressive new design. The corridor and 6 of the rooms have interestingly modern designs. Some of these Executive “Flow & Art” rooms, do not have balconies – instead they have art and an interesting new refurbishment!
- 16 of the standard single rooms have now been renovated in a modern “designer” style. They are still fairly small but look great!
- Most of the triple rooms have been repainted and equipped with 3 single beds rather than bunks – looking very nice!

- **Continental breakfast** has now been up-graded to a self-service “Mediterranean breakfast” including: hot drinks (coffee, chocolate, tea), fresh orange juice, a wide selection of different bread rolls for toasting or stuffing, ham, cheese, tomato, cereals, yoghourts, croissants, doughnuts and other pastries. **To avoid occasional misunderstandings that have arisen, the breakfast ticket will allow students to choose freely from the breakfast buffet.**
- **Lunch/dinner:** there is now a much wider choice in a self-service format. Various freshly cooked dishes, soup, salads, pastas ... If a student does not see what they want in the self-service area they can choose a main course from the a la carte menu including meat, fish, pizzas, pasta etc. at no extra cost. The meal ticket includes 3 courses + drink.
- **Half Board consists of:** breakfast every day, lunch (Mon-Fri) and dinner on Sundays
- **Full Board consists of:** breakfast every day, lunch Mon-Fri and dinner every day except Saturday.

*NB: If the restaurant is closed for a bank holiday or other reason, students with half board will be able to make up the missed meal(s) on another evening and those on full board will be given a free place on one of our tapas tours.*

## Club Hispánico and Host Family Accommodation: Notes

1. The arrivals day is Sunday and departures are on Saturday morning. Therefore 2 weeks = 13 nights, 3 weeks = 20 nights, 4 weeks = 27 nights etc. Minimum stay is 2 weeks (except in the case of Spanish for Business, 1-1, **Young Adult Course in Spring** and the 1-week versions of Spanish & Cookery, Spanish & Dance and the Teachers course).
2. All durations are calculated at the nightly price.
3. Students booking the Young Adult or Young Adult Plus course for 1 week in the Spring, should book 7 nights (Sun/Sun or Sat/Sat) if they want the full-day excursion which is included in the price. There can be no refund for excursions not used.
4. There can be no price reductions for students wanting less than 13 nights (excepting the courses mentioned in point 1 above).

5. If, due to flight schedules, students need one extra night, this can usually be arranged on a request basis. The extra night will always be charged.
6. Free access to WiFi is now guaranteed in all host families as well as throughout the Club Hispanico

## Student Apartments: Notes

Type A and Type B apartments are differentiated as follows:

- Type A apartments
  - Within 10 minutes walk of the school
  - Air conditioning
  - Higher level of furnishings and facilities
  - Access to swimming pool (usually from May through October only)
  - Single or twin rooms, self catering
  - Shared bathroom(s), living room and kitchen
  - Safe deposit box in each bedroom
- Type B apartments
  - Within 30 minutes travel time to the school
  - Easy access to public transport and shops/services
  - Comfortable furnishings
  - Single or twin rooms, self catering
  - Shared bathroom(s), living room and kitchen

All our apartments are guaranteed to have the following minimum standards and services:

- Access to WiFi is now guaranteed in all our shared student apartments
- Kitchen – gas or electric cooking rings and micro-wave or conventional oven
- TV and clothes washing machine
- Maintenance – unlike privately rented apartments, we provide a maintenance service at no extra cost

- Services – there is NO extra charge for electricity, gas, water, etc. We clean the general area and bedrooms (as and when possible) once every 2 weeks. Sheets are changed each week. Otherwise the students are responsible for keeping the apartments tidy.

Bookings in apartments are accepted for between 2 weeks and 8 weeks. There will never be a refund if the student leaves this accommodation early. If a student wants to prolong his/her stay in an apartment we need 4 weeks' notice.

We introduced the rule of maximum 8 weeks duration for the initial booking a few years ago as we had found that long-stay students invariably decided to look for their own apartments to share amongst a group of friends as this appeared to be cheaper (usually not the case!). It has proved to be a very successful policy and we are continuing with it. However if you feel that your particular market depends on the sale of longer durations in apartments please tell us and we will work out the necessary compromise.

## High Season Supplement

There is a supplement of **€ 8.00 per night** from *10 June until and including the night of 8 September* on all types of accommodation.
