NSTS Malta knows its origins way back to 1954 when it was founded within the statutes of the University of Malta by the Student Representative Council specifically to promote international friendships and understanding as well as intercultural relations among university students within the framework of the International Student Travel Confederation.

Its voluntary set-up was instrumental for many local university students to venture into Europe to meet their counterparts and to further their tertiary education. These acted as Malta's first promotional ambassadors and very soon European students were descending upon Malta to follow programmed educational activities in archaeology, later in 1963 in English language, and since 2008 at High School alongside English speaking Maltese students.

It today operates as a Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO) under the governance of a non-profit philanthropic foundation executive made up of volunteers, nominated in their majority by the University of Malta and Student Council. Its mission is to provide the discerning global student with valued holistic educational experiences and meaningful engagements in English.

The unique characteristic of Malta as a study destination, distinct from all other more known countries, is its geographically compact size of only 300 square kilometres. This makes all locations only a few kilometres apart and easily accessible on foot or by public transport.

The pleasant and casual youthful lifestyle is another attribute that contributes to Malta's marked increase in popularity among high school study abroad international students.

You will unwind in sunny open-air cafes, trek in the countryside, paddle in some charming small bay, share your life experiences and enjoy each other's company.
