



DATES & TRIP REQUIREMENTS

Students arrive in Canada and are transported to Appleby College on Friday, June 28, and then travel to Camp Kandalore on Saturday, June 29. Students then travel back to Appleby on Friday, July 12 and complete the remaining 2 weeks of their Appleby Academy Boarding experience, taking part in engaging classes and on excursions to the region's best attractions. They depart from Appleby and fly out from Canada on Saturday, July 27.

This program is offered to international students ages 12-15 with high intermediate to advanced English. This is an exclusive program with only limited spaces available in summer 2024.
