COSTA RICA

Costa Rica is by far one of the most exotic places on Earth. The country offers unparalleled natural beauty, white sand beaches, rainforests, and a wide range of national parks. Costa Rica is located in Central America and borders Nicaragua to the north and Panama to the south. A chain of mountains—part of the Andean-Sierra Madre chain—runs the length of the country and separates the Caribbean Sea on the east coast from the Pacific Ocean on the west coast. Costa Rica has thousands of miles of gorgeous coastline, copious amounts of sunshine, which makes it the most inspirational learning environments in the world!

DAILY ROUTINE

Every day, Spanish campers immerse themselves in the Spanish language while participating in a variety of activities and events around the capital city of San Jose and the beach towns of Manuel Antonio and Quepos. Students learn about the history and culture of Costa Rica and experience first-hand the country's amazing people and vast natural resources!

Monday through Friday, students eat breakfast prior to being picked up and taken to their Spanish class. Spanish classes run from 9 AM to 12 PM daily. After class, lunch is catered at the school. In the afternoon, from 1 PM to 4 PM, students, breakout for their afternoon activites and tours. After which, they return to their host family for dinner and showers, and then get ready for the camp's evening events.

During weeknights, planned activities include salsa lessons, bonfires, karaoke, Costa Rican BBQs, game nights, movie nights, as well as quality time and Spanish language practice with host families. On weekends, students take part in exciting cultural adventures and nature tours led by our professional guides and chaperones. Costa Rica is one of the most beautiful and biologically diverse travel destinations on the planet and Spanish Camp never disappoints!

BEACH DAY

Campers head to the white sand beaches of Manuel Antonio for a day of fun in the sun

LY TOUR

Campers learn about the history of San Jose and visit the main points of interest in the capital city. The tour includes a visit to the San Jose downtown area, "Plaza de Cultura," Costa Rica's first Airport, the National Theater, Central Avenue and the Central Market

COFFEE FARM

Campers experience the original Costa Rican coffee tour to learn how coffee plays an integral part in the local culture and economy. Participants learn how coffee is grown, roasted, and processed from bean to cup!

COOKING CLASS

Campers learn how to prepare typical Costa Rican food, such as tamales and empanadas in a participatory cooking class taught by one of our Costa Rican host mothers.

COSTA RICA BBQ

Campers come together to enjoy a typical Costa Rican barbecue and traditional 'Tica' music.

DAY WITH HOST FAMILY This is an opportunity to spend a day with the "familia." The host family includes your teen in the family's daily routine, which might involve cooking dinner, shopping, visiting relatives, and other family activities.

JUNGLE ZIPLINE

AVENGER

Campers explore the mall -or the beachthrough a scavenger hunt, where they have a list of clues in Spanish that guide them from place to place.

ANUEL ANTONI NATIONAL PARK

An experienced nature guide leads campers on an informative hike through Costa Rica's most famous national park. Campers enjoy small beaches, ocean inlets, and see a variety of wildlife.

GO KARTS

Campers get an adrenaline rush by racing each other and Maximo Nivel staff around the indoor go kart track in San Jose!

MOVIE NIGHT

Campers watch movies in Spanish or in English with Spanish subtitles—both ways to learn new vocabulary and then practice Spanish.

MUSEUM TOURS

Campers visit San Jose's most historic and architecturally-significant buildings and learn about Costa Rica during Pre-Colombian times. This tour immerses students in the country's rich culture and history with visits to the National Museum and Jade Museum.

OROSI VALLEY

Orosi is home to "La Iglesia Colonial de Orosi"—the oldest church in Costa Rica. Campers also visit "Las Ruinas de Ujarras" and "Puente de Hamaca Peatonal."

SALSA CLASS

A fun and relaxed dance class taught by our local professional Salsa instructor. Beyond just Salsa, campers learn other popular Latin American dances, such as Merengue and Bachata.

SCUBA DIVING

Campers take part in a 2-day introductory "discover scuba" course, taught by a former U.S. Coast Guard diver. The course includes one day of safety and equipment training in a swimming pool and a one day supervised ocean dive. Note, students can opt out of the scuba course and enjoy other Spanish Camp activities during this time.

SERVICE LEARNING

Campers learn more about giving back and being global citizens by getting involved at local schools, communities, and child care centers. Work includes organizing activities with the children, teaching English, and light construction. This is an excellent day to learn more about community service and volunteering abroad.

SOUVENIR

Campers visit traditional markets and local stores to buy Costa Rican coffee, hand-made jewelry, carved wood handicrafts, and other souvenirs for their family and friends back home.

SPORTS & RECREATION Campers spend the afternoon at a local sports facility such as an indoor soccer field, trampoline park, or basketball court. Members of the Spanish camp community, including host families and Maximo Nivel staff, join in for a rousing game of soccer, the most popular sport in Costa Rica!

IDE SCHOOL

Campers spend the day on one of the most beautiful beaches in Costa Rica. Our professional surf instructor teaches everyone how to ride the waves! Students also get to spend time body surfing, boogy boarding, and paddle boarding. Less adventurous teens can choose to just relax on the beach and watch their friends.

RAM LUNA

VOLCANO & HOT SPRINGS Campers experience the fascinating rainforest in Manuel Antonio at night! This is the best time to observe and photograph beautiful tree frogs, colorful insects, and other elusive rainforest creatures.

The Ram Luna center is perched high above the mountains overlooking San Jose. From this unique vantage point, campers enjoy panoramic views of the Central Valley and explore 'Tico' folklore through traditional dances and marimba music. There's also a delicious dinner buffet with traditional Costa Rican dishes.

This excursion takes campers to the Irazu Volcano National Park, Orosi Basilica, and the Hacienda Orosi Hot Springs. Students tour the impressive volcano site and visit other points of interest around the Orosi Valley. A relaxing afternoon in the hot springs caps off the tour, and students enjoy a traditional lunch.

Campers get to experience the lush vegetation and beautiful views of the Orosi Valley amidst a tour of several significant pieces of Costa Rican history! This afternoon activity includes a visit to the oldest church in Costa Rica, "La Iglesia Colonial de Orosi," and the ruins of the neighboring Ujarras village.
