Channel School of English

Our school is situated within the green flag award winning Bicclescombe Park, in the picturesque harbour town of Ilfracombe, North Devon. It is a beautiful spacious Victorian building with a lot of history and stories to tell!

We have 14 well equipped classrooms, a student room to chill out at break times and a picnic area to enjoy the barbecues at lunch.

Channel School is open all year round for groups and during Easter and summer for individuals.

Class sizes average 12 students (maximum class size 15) and are mixed nationality wherever possible to increase English speaking opportunities.











Ilfracombe North Devon

Ilfracombe is a small seaside town on the North Devon coast in the South West of England.

The town is a safe place to be with a welcoming and traditional community. The town is easy to navigate around. The students that come here love socialising in the evenings and watching the sun set.

Nearby Locations

Woolacombe beach is just 10 minutes away. Awarded as the best beach in the UK in 2015, 2016, 2019 and 2021, it is always in the top 5 beaches in the UK. It is a real capital for surfing and other water sports.

The vibrant market town of Barnstaple is only 25 minutes away and provides big-name high street shops, along with great restaurants.

Exeter, the Country regional centre, is just over an hour away and offers all the facilities and amenities to be expected in a modern university city.



Saturday only Airport Transfers

- Arrivals:

Our students' experience starts the moment they arrive in England.

We pick up from London Heathrow, Bristol or Exeter airports, as well as St. Pancras train station in London. Our team is always there to meet them at the airport and transport them to the South West of England in our own fleet of sign-written coaches.

On arrival in Ilfracombe they will be welcomed by their homestay and go home with them.

Times for arriving in Ilfracombe are: After 4pm and before 10pm

- Departures:

Every student is escorted to the check-in desk in time for their flight or train.

Unaccompanied minors outside of our escort times will be charged at £73 per hour.

Departures from Ilfracombe are:

After 6am and before 10pm

If your fight is delayed, more than an hour there will be extra escort waiting / parking charges at £73 per hour.

Please make sure that your travel insurance will cover this.

Our staff escort times:

- London St. Pancras train station: From 1pm to 2pm, trains must arrive between 1pm & 2pm, depart: 2 to 4pm

- London Heathrow airport: From 11am to 2:30pm (in all terminals) Bus will arrive at 11am, depart at 3pm

- Bristol and Exeter airports:

Only at 8am, 2pm and 8:30pm. Flights must be between 10:30am & 8pm

- London Gatwick airport:

From 1pm to 2pm, must arrive before 1pm and depart between 3pm & 6pm

On arrival, students must wait by the arrival gate for our escort.

We need <u>flight details</u> and if booked as an <u>unaccompanied minor</u>.









Welcome Meetings - Sundays

Every Sunday we have an induction meeting at 11:30, where our team greets the students and explains their activity programme, shows them around the school and answers any questions they may have.

Students receive a welcome package including a student card, wristband, map and timetable for the week.

After the induction meeting students go back to have lunch with their families, spend time getting to know each other and familiarise themselves with the town. Homestays will bring students to the meeting.

First day at School - Mondays

On the first day students are divided into three sets according to age and choice of activity programme. This enables us to get a great international mix in activities and lessons, which encourages students to always speak English and make new international friends.

At Channel School of English we have three student sets:

Yellow: 6 – 13 years old Green: 12 – 16 years old Purple: 14 – 17 years old

Teaching & Learning Experiential English


We have a dynamic and approachable teaching team who are all experienced and qualified teachers. They are continually observed and encouraged to develop professionally.

Emphasis is placed on improving speaking, listening and functional language skills. Speech is initiated with many exercises from pair and group work to individual presentations, group discussions, debates, role-plays, simulations, music, drama and games.


Materials are varied. lively and up-to-date. The use of technology in the classrooms has opened up a new world of engagement, personalised learning and collaboration for our iunior students.

Every classroom has Wi-Fi and is equipped with a projector. Students are provided with tablets to carry out blended-learning activities. Students take an initial language assessment test and are allocated to the class best suited to their linguistic ability and level (A2, B1, B2, or C1).

Students will receive a course certificate at the end of their course with the level they have been learning at and their teacher's personal comments.



Living in homestay accommodation gives your child the perfect opportunity to experience English life and to practise their language skills in everyday situations.



We offer a friendly and professional guardianship service for our students studying in independent boarding schools in the South West of England. All you need to do is contact us and we can promptly help. Prices vary depeding on length of stay.

- We liaise closely with the school regarding academic progress and as required will attend on your behalf at parent's evenings and open events.
- Provide advice and access to academic advisors and tutors if required.
- Ensure a dedicated Host family for exeat weekends and half terms as needed. We visit every family we work with at their home, they are interviewed and vetted by Country Cousins, including two references and a full security check through the UK Home Office. You will receive a visit report.
- We always ensure that there is an opportunity to visit the homestay if you are visiting England or will organise a Video chat if you are not but would like to talk to them directly.
- 24/7 emergency response service for support for your child, you or their school.



We have seen that for students who attend Channel School of English, complete immersion in an English school is often the next natural step. The minimum level of English is B1. Students must be between 12 and 16 years old.

Country Cousins can arrange for students to spend a term or a year at a local college or secondary school in North Devon, studying subjects within the English National Curriculum.

Students can board at the private school or stay with a host family as day students, with Country Cousins acting as guardians. The minimum course length is 3 weeks.


