

Junior Accommodation

There is a choice of both **Residential** and **Homestay** accommodation

Surfers Bay

- A large 21 bedroom house, which comfortably sleeps up to 45 students + 3 Group Leader rooms.
- Large games room and communal space
- This accommodation is a 10 minute walk from school and 1 minute from the town centre.
- It has beautiful sea and mountain views.



Portbeg Complex

- A small complex of spacious 4 bedroom houses.
- 4 bedrooms, 3 to 4 bathrooms, a spacious kitchen, sitting room and all mod cons.
- A quiet cul de sac less than one minute's walk from the Atlantic Ocean and 3 minutes from schoo
- 15 minutes walk from the town centre.
- Based on 8 11 students (three to four students per room and 1 coordinator per house.

Host Family

- Carefully selected hosts
