



The Full Study Course at OISE Badminton

The Full Study Course (22.5 hours per week, 6-8 students per class)

Location and Centre

Situated approximately 20km from Bath, 120km from Oxford and 205km from London, Bristol is a hub of social and cultural attractions such as the Clifton Suspension Bridge, the Exploratory Science Museum, various museums and art galleries as well as a lively shopping scene.

Badminton school, over 150 years old with an internationally renowned reputation, has hosted an OISE junior course for many years. Located just to the north of Bristol, students will find the local shops of Westbury-on-Trym a short walk away, and Bristol itself is served by regular buses.

Set in its own beautifully landscaped grounds, the school has excellent sports facilities including tennis courts, a heated swimming pool and an indoor sports hall.

The soul behind the Full Study Course lies in the combination of the academic aspects of language development and an understanding of the enthralling world in which it is used. The course reshapes perceptions so that young learners continue to digest language tuition in a manner that excites and interests them. Most prominently, the course imparts an authoritative voice upon students that enables greater confidence in both their native tongue and their new language.





Accommodation

Students are accommodated in the school residences in small dormitories of between 4 and 6 students with en-suite bathroom facilities. Meals are provided in the school dining hall. Special dietary requirements can be considered and a vegetarian option is always available.

Activities and Excursions

Afternoon games include sports, such as football, cricket, volleyball, tennis and swimming. Other activities include jewellery making, dance lessons, fashion design, decorative painting and mosaics. In the evenings typical activities include quiz and casino nights, disco, film and games nights, talent show, theatre workshop, fashion show and teacher versus students sports, music workshops, card tournament and karaoke

Every Saturday there is a full day excursion either to London, Oxford or an outing to the city of Cardiff, with visits to the Millennium Stadium, Cardiff Castle, shopping and a boat trip. Sundays are filled with local excursions to Bath, Bristol Museum or Bristol Zoo.

Travel

Young Learners are greeted by members of the OISE courier team from certain airports and stations within standard hours as part of the package. Students are then accompanied to the Welcome Lounge, a facility with food, refreshments and activities to keep students occupied until they are taken onward to the school.
