Location and Centre

Devon is home to some of the UK's finest beaches and traditional seaside resorts, of which Dawlish, on the south coast of the county, is no exception. Situated 300km south west of London, this small but lively town has played host to many happy holiday makers over the years.

With a capacity limited to 48 students, OISE Dawlish has a warm family atmosphere which makes it perfect for those who are visiting England for the first time. The school itself is nestled in picture-perfect grounds complete with a trickling stream.

Due to its exclusive seaside location, the programme can be specially tailored to include activities on the beach - always a popular option!

The Intensive Summer Curriculum (27 hours per week, maximum 8 students per class)

Accommodation

Accommodation is with host families living in Dawlish and nearby Teignmouth, a five minutes bus or train journey along the seafront to school. All host families are thoroughly inspected and their credentials checked. There will be no other student of the same mother tongue in the house.

Activities and Excursions

One evening per week there will be a social activity for all students. Typical activities include film nights, barbecues, talent and fashion shows, quiz nights, art challenges, casino nights and theatre workshops. On Wednesdays students will visit local points of interest in Dawlish and surrounding areas. Every Saturday, there is a full day excursion to a place of historic or architectural interest such as the Barbican Centre in Plymouth, an outing to the National Marine Aquarium or a visit to the city of Exeter. Sundays will be spent with the host family.

Travel

Young Learners are greeted by members of the OISE travel team at designated airports, within standard hours, as part of the package. Students arriving in London are then transferred to the nearby Welcome Lounge, a facility with food, refreshments and activities to keep students occupied until they are taken onward to the school.

Standard transfer times:

London Heathrow (LHR) – 4.5 hours

London Gatwick (LGW) – 6 hours

Bristol Airport (BRS) – 2 hours
