Location and Centre

Situated near Warwick and Stratford-upon-Avon, Sherbourne is a beautiful village located in the English county of Warwickshire. Set in the midst of historical attractions associated with Anglo-Saxon history, Sherbourne is rich in English culture. The school is just 10 minutes away from Warwick Castle and only 15 minutes from the birthplace of William Shakespeare.

Sherbourne Priors is a charming Victorian country house that provides a safe and friendly atmosphere for younger students. All staff live on campus, giving the centre a real family feel which encourages the youngest learners to flourish in their linguistic abilities. Alongside the academic programme there is an exciting activity schedule and full day excursions on the weekend.

Students on this programme build their language competence through the normal primary school curriculum, allowing the children to engage immediately with the living reality of the language. The children grow in stature as they gradually realise that they can operate in English and thus conduct their daily life as an English speaker. The day at Sherbourne is balanced between structured lessons during the morning and applied learning activities in the afternoon. English is the language of the whole experience. Within the day the children learn to speak, read and write alongside mathematics, sciences, history and geography.





Accommodation

Dormitories within the Sherbourne Priors building offer a comfortable place to stay where staff are always available to ensure the security and safety of students, as well as offer pastoral care. Rooms are for 2-4 sharing with en-suite facilities. Special care is taken to put students of a similar age and ability in the same rooms.



Activities and Excursions

Activities include swimming, computer games, arts and crafts, birds of prey display, theatre workshop, circus skills, bowling, dance, talent shows, shopping trip, disco, barbecue, card games, treasure hunts and games on the field.

Every Saturday there is a full day excursion either to Cotswolds Wildlife Park, Warwick Castle, Stratford Upon Avon or Oxford. The timetable also includes weekly field trips and local excursions on Sundays.

Travel

Children are greeted by members of the OISE courier team from certain airports within standard hours as part of the package. Students arriving outside of the summer months will be taken straight from the airport to the school. Students arriving during summer will be accompanied from the airport to the Welcome Lounge. The Welcome Lounge, a supervised facility with food, refreshments and activities to keep students occupied until they are taken onward to the school.
